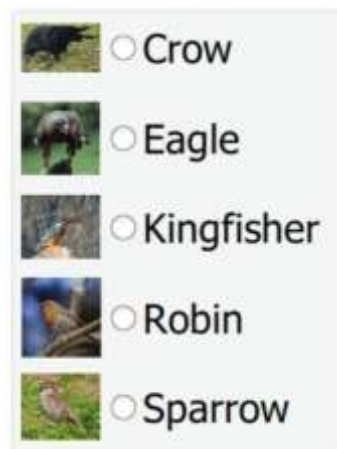
- Tip of the day: Use the calculate question type to work out an answer and use it as an input to other questions.
